

Is it a business or a lifestyle? Yes! This beautiful farm lies in the shadow of Fishers Peak and features 33.6 acres of peace and quiet. Enter the property and pass the office, greenhouses, irrigated beds and follow the drive along to a 2000 built log home with 2 car garage. The home sits like a jewel in the middle of the property and looks like a mountain cabin. Enjoy the wide front porch as it gazes out on the nursery and the mountains. The home features approx. 2070 sf, with 2 bedrooms on the main level with 2 full baths and 2 bedrooms on the upper level with a half bath. There is a full basement with walk out double doors. The home was custom built and includes unique details like angled tongue and groove boards, stone faced fireplace and lodge style loft. The master bedroom is on the 'mountain view' side with lots of windows and features a large bath suite with walk in closet and Jacuzzi tub. The home has hardwood floors throughout - except for the baths and mudroom which have ceramic tile. The kitchen is open to the living areas for great flow and entertaining possibilities with lots of cabinets and counter top space, dishwasher, built in oven and cook top. The dining area is placed before the French Doors that lead to a large deck. There is another bedroom on the main level with a full bath nearby. The hallway to the garage holds a walk in pantry, washer / dryer and an area to take your boots off. From the large deck enjoy nature and seeing wildlife - no neighbors in sight! The upstairs features a large open loft that would be perfect for office, den or music room. There are two bedrooms on either side and a half bath on this level. The basement has a woodstove, storage area, and can be used for gym equipment and lawn equipment storage. The business part includes an office / workshop with a 'cabin' look to match the home. Inside there is an office and a large workshop for every power tool or 'toy'. The workshop is plumbed for a bath if a living quarters is required. There are 5 greenhouses for every need. Meadows are used for growing stock of primarily Leyland cypress. It feels like you can reach out and touch the mountains - what a great view!
